The current main hall planned changes include bifold doors overlooking the park which eventually (subject to funding will have a veranda overlooking the park)

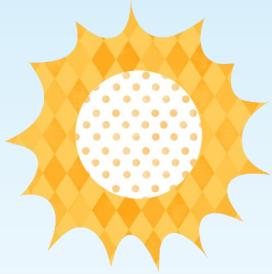
Part of the Natural networks application is to incorporate drainpipe planters which could incorporate the sensory garden theme.
